1. PARENTAL RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

A parent who intends to relocate the residence of a child who is subject to this Order must provide the other parent prior actual notice at least 30 days before the intended relocation. Such notice shall include the address and, if known, the telephone number of the residence where the parent intends to relocate the child.
